Many of you know the history of how our Club was created. However, each time we give a tour to new Members they are stunned to learn the Club has always been in the same location for over 40 years. They always love hearing the story of how the Club was developed.

To recap our history.....In 1963 William Morris III saw a need for Augusta to have a city club to conduct the town's professional, business and social affairs. He wanted a place that was private, with excellent food, great ambience, and superb service with a commanding view. He knew the Georgia Railroad Bank was in the process of building a skyscraper in downtown Augusta. Mr. Morris contacted the Chairman of the bank, Sherman Drawdy, requesting two additional floors with higher ceilings and a spectacular view of the Savannah River.

The Pinnacle Club was incorporated on June 17, 1965 and opened for business on September 5, 1967. An elegant Grand Opening Gala was held on September 9th to officially announce its arrival on Augusta's social and business scene. Each year we celebrate the milestones of the Club with our Annual President's Ball.

This year we set the stage for another grand evening with the theme "Champagne, Rhythm & Pearls". Guests will be dazzled with lavish Floral Displays, Spectacular Ice Carvings, International Cuisine, your choice of Libations and lots of Sultry Sounds.
